Vaping introduces nicotine into the body just like smoking tobacco, and increases risk for gum disease, bad breath, yellow teeth, black hairy tongue, dry mouth, red or bleeding gums, and tooth loss. WIC Survey (Goal 1, Obj. 1)	Sarah DP reviewed WIC – 1 and 2 Year Old Dental Care survey results. During the fall of 2018 – through spring 2019, Eau Claire County WIC surveyed participants with 1 to 3-year old children on their dental care behaviors for their children. Of those who completed the survey, 194 were mothers of 1-year-olds and 9 were mothers of 2 or 4-year-olds.
