



## **Healthy Relationship Promotion Action Team –Minutes**

### **1. Welcome & updates**

- a. Amanda shared that they have new two Sexual Assault Advocate at the Family Support center in Chippewa. They are also hiring an Advocate for Eau Claire County. If you know anyone, send them to Amanda's way. Family Support Center in Eau Claire is moving locations in a couple months (down Barstow Street).
- b. HRPAT/Health Department did receive the Sexual Violence Program Grant. Don't know all the details yet, but this will be exciting for our action team! This will help support Safe Dates and expand more into policy work.
  - i. Abby shared about the resources - Coaching Boys Into Men. It's one of the resources in the Healthy Relationship Promotion Toolkit and also one of the CDC recommended curriculums for sexual violence prevention. This video is a really good intro to the program: <https://youtu.be/uFcfHBH7Mf8>. Talked about sharing this with our community as we move forward with the grant work. Grant work involves engaging men and boys into sexual violence prevention. Discussed making sure it is trauma-informed and recognizes different experiences males have had.
- c. COACH Site visit is upcoming on Monday, February 24<sup>th</sup>. Plan to spend the time around policy analysis. If you didn't get an invite, let Abby know. Abby will bring thank you card to next meeting to sign for Alan and Maria.

- b. Discussed the history of the Celebration Award. Came up with ideas of Life without Limits and SPARK program.

- a. Update if you've shared the toolkit/need business cards.

- d. Chippewa Valley Family Article- March/April
  - i. Discussed consent at every age article- 300-600 words. Due February 15<sup>th</sup>. Amanda volunteered to write a draft.

## **6. Feb Book Event/Discussion**

- a. Emily has been talking with librarian at LE Phillips Library about a book event/activity in February. The teen section is on the main floor of the library, so there are big windows that we could use as a “display”.
  - i. Discussed Teen dating violence theme- #onething. One thing you want to bring to a relationship/ positive quality. Have a display with post it notes.
