1. Welcome & updates

- a. Abby and Emily shared about Jackson Katz. He is an activist and gender violence expert. He will be presenting about toxic masculinity as part of UW-Eau Claire's Forum Series. The presentation is scheduled for Tuesday, March 10, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. in Schofield Auditorium. HRPAT has permission to table at this event and may be invited to a private event afterwards.
- b. Abby informed the group that the Health Dept should receive an answer from DHS by January regarding the sexual violence prevention grant.

2. Toolkit dissemination/evaluation (Goal 1)

 - i. Emily shared information about the La Crosse YMCA doing a rollout of a mental health toolkit. YMCA might roll it out to all of the YMCAs across the state depending on its success.  - ii. Abby attended the Warp Speed event. She gave out fifteen toolkits and bunches of business cards. The audience seemed interested in the toolkit.
